Konstantine also represents individuals and companies in connection with criminal and grand jury investigations. Much of Konstantine's practice involves negotiating with private civil lawyers and government prosecutors. Konstantine also interacts with civil and criminal investigators including, but not limited to, the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), Internal Revenue Service (IRS), and Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC).
